#### Introduction

The **Indore Institute of Management and Research (IIMR)** recognizes that its teaching and non-teaching staff are vital to the institution's success. The institute is committed to creating a supportive, motivating environment for its employees, which is essential for maintaining high levels of satisfaction and performance. Below are the key welfare measures and the Performance Appraisal System (PAS) in place at IIMR:

#### Welfare Measures for Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff

IIMR offers a range of welfare initiatives that reflect the institution's commitment to the well-being of its employees:

- No-Interest Loan and NOC: Teaching and non-teaching staff are eligible for no-interest loans and a No Objection Certificate (NOC) as part of the institute's support for personal and professional needs.
- Staff Children's Education: To support staff members, IIMR offers half-fee admissions for the children of its employees, recognizing the value of education for their families.
- Academic Leaves: Staff members pursuing higher education or professional courses are granted academic leaves to encourage continued learning and professional development.
- Research and Development Support: The institution provides well-equipped labs that
  are accessible to staff for research purposes and to keep up with the latest developments
  in their field.
- Professional Growth Opportunities: IIMR supports staff participation in various programs organized by the institute and external agencies. The institution provides leaves and financial incentives for such participation.
- Maternity Leave: Female employees receive maternity leave with half-salary for two months, supporting their health and family needs.
- Crèche Facility for Lactating Mothers: A special crèche facility is available for lactating mothers, offering a dedicated room with a caretaker for their babies. The institute also accommodates flexible working hours to support mothers' needs.





- Staff Accommodation: Staff can avail of staff quarters at concessional rates, making it easier for employees to live near the campus.
- Health-Conscious Initiatives: IIMR grows its own organic vegetables, fruits, and grains on campus, which are sourced to the canteen, promoting healthier food options for staff.
- Transport Facility: Free transport is provided to all employees within Indore and up to 60 km outside the city. Employees are also offered pick-up and drop-off facilities if they need to stay after working hours or visit the campus on holidays. Vehicle pooling is encouraged as part of green initiatives and financial benefits.
- Wi-Fi Access: IIMR offers a fully Wi-Fi-enabled campus, providing employees with free internet access 24/7 on both desktop and personal laptops.
- Library Access: All employees have access to the campus library during designated hours, supporting continuous learning.
- Recreational Facilities: A variety of indoor games like Table Tennis, Chess, and Carrom, as well as outdoor games like Pickleball, Cricket, Basketball, and Tennis, are available for staff to enjoy during their free time, fostering physical and mental well-being.
- Canteen Facility: The campus canteen provides healthy and subsidized food for employees, supporting a balanced lifestyle.
- Social Gatherings: The management organizes get-togethers and lunches where employees can participate in cultural performances, building a strong sense of community and camaraderie.
- Retirement Benefits: IIMR contributes a specific amount towards the Employee Provident Fund (EPF) and Gratuity benefits for eligible teaching and non-teaching staff, ensuring financial security for employees' post-retirement.
- ESIC and Minimum Wages Compliance: As per government regulations, IIMR contributes to the Employee State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) and adheres to minimum wage guidelines for non-teaching and fourth-class employees.
