### Feedback Analysis of Students Feedback on Curriculum

Parameter/ Assessment Criteria	Analysis Result
1. Rate how adaptable was the syllabus offered by the courses.	The majority of students (80) strongly agreed that the syllabus offered by the courses is adaptable. 78 agreed to the same. However, 14 were not sure.
2. How do you find the appropriateness of the sequence of the courses provided in the curriculum?	The majority of students (101) agreed that the sequence of the courses in the curriculum is appropriate. 41 expressed strong agreement to the same. However, 28 were not sure and 2 expressed disagreement
3. How do you rate the depth of the syllabus of the courses in relation to the competencies expected by industry/ global scenario?	The majority of students (91) agreed that the depth of the syllabus is in relation to the competencies of the industry expectations. However, 39 students expressed Disagreement and a strong agreement as well in this parameter
4. How would you rate the sequence of units/ modules in the courses?	Majority of students – 38 and 97- strongly agreed and agreed , respectively, with the effectiveness of the sequence of units/modules in the syllabus. However 28 were not sure and 9 disagreed with the same
5. Rate the adequateness of the textbooks and reference books mentioned for the courses	Majority of students (101) agreed with the adequateness of the books and references mentioned in the courses; 29 strongly agreed and 37, 4 and 1 student/s marked their response as not sure, disagree and strongly disagree.
6. How would you rate the design of the courses in terms of extra learning or self-learning?	41 students responded strongly agree to this question. 63 agreed and 63 were not sure of the same. 5 students disagreed.
7. How would you rate the flexibility in choosing the electives in relation to technology advancements?	In absence of much scope of electives, 31 students marked unsure. However considering the freedom to select specialization in BBA and MBA, 79 and 55 students marked as strongly agree and agree, to this statement. However 7 students disagreed



8. How would you rate the percentage of learning ICT skills through courses offered?	Majority (83) have agreed that the ICT skills can be learned through courses. 45, 40, 3 and 1 marked it as Agree, Not Sure, Disagree and Strongly Disagree.
9. The objectivity of assessment and evaluation	81 students agreed that the objectives of the assessment and evaluation is met. 57 students also marked the same as agreed. However 34 students were unsure of the same
10. Overall rating of the program	83 and 67 students seemed satisfied with the overall program. 20 students marked this area as neutral and 2 disagreed with the same

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
