Parameter/ Assessment Criteria	Analysis Result
1. Rate how adaptable was the syllabus offered by the courses.	<p>The majority of students (72) strongly agreed that the syllabus offered by the courses is adaptable. 75 agreed to the same. However, 25 were not sure and 2 disagreed.</p> <p>This leads to a weighted mean of 4.25</p>
2. How do you find the appropriateness of the sequence of the courses provided in the curriculum?	<p>The majority of students (92) agreed that the sequence of the courses in the curriculum is appropriate. 44 expressed strong agreement to the same. However, 34 were not sure and 4 expressed disagreement</p> <p>This leads to a weighted mean of 4.01</p>
3. How do you rate the depth of the syllabus of the courses in relation to the competencies expected by industry/ global scenario?	<p>The majority of students (102) agreed that the depth of the syllabus is in relation to the competencies of the industry expectations. However, 29 students expressed strong agreement as well in this parameter. 38 were not sure and 5 disagreed</p> <p>This leads to a weighted mean of 3.93</p>
4. How would you rate the sequence of units/ modules in the courses?	<p>Majority of students – 94- strongly agreed and 37 agreed with the effectiveness of the sequence of units/modules in the syllabus. However 37 were not sure and 6 disagreed with the same</p> <p>This leads to a weighted mean of 3.93</p>
5. Rate the adequateness of the textbooks and reference books mentioned for the courses	<p>Majority of students (46) are unsure about the adequateness of the books. 94 agreed with the adequateness of the books and references mentioned in the courses; 9 and 1 student/s marked their response as disagree and strongly disagree.</p> <p>This leads to a weighted mean of 3.75</p>
6. How would you rate the design of the courses in terms of extra learning or self-learning?	<p>68 students responded strongly agree to this question. 56 agreed and 45 were not sure of the same. 2 students disagreed.</p> <p>This leads to a weighted mean of 4.06</p>
7. How would you rate the flexibility in choosing the electives in relation to technology advancements?	<p>In absence of much scope of electives, 45 students marked unsure. However considering the freedom to select specialization in BBA and MBA, 68 and 56 students marked as strongly agree and agree, to this statement. However, 5 students disagreed</p> <p>This leads to a weighted mean of 4.16</p>



8. How would you rate the percentage of learning ICT skills through courses offered?	Majority (79) have agreed tha the ICT skills can be learned through courses. 46, 47, and 2 marked it as Agree, Not Sure, and Disagree. This leads to a weighted mean of 4.19
9. The objectivity of assessment and evaluation	76 students agreed that the objectives of the assessment and evaluation is met. 59 students also marked the same as agreed. However 38 students were unsure of the same This leads to a weighted mean of 4.20
10. Overall rating of the program	85 and 54 students seemed satisfied with the overall program. 33 students marked this area as neutral and 2 disagreed with the same This leads to a weighted mean of 4.28
