



## **Students' Feedback Analysis Report on Curriculum for the Academic Year 2020-21**

### **Feedback analysis of Student Feedback on The Curriculum Design of the Institute**

#### **Academic Session - 2020-21**

1. Structured Feedback was received from 134 Students of IIMR in the Academic Session 2020-21 regarding the design of Syllabus and its review from all the streams of Commerce, Management and Science, post the completion of the syllabus
2. Detailed Analysis was done for each parameter and the average was derived to understand the perception of students on a 5-Point Likert Scale, where 1 indicated Strongly Disagree and 5 indicated Strongly Agree.
3. Majority of Students "Agreed" that the curriculum is adaptable and appropriate to their needs and contributes well towards their studies.
4. Many students have "Strongly Agreed" that the depth of the syllabus and the sequencing of the units is good and competent for industrial and global scenario.
5. Majority of Students have "Agreed" that the course is flexible and thereby they help them in extra/self-learning. Many are "Not Sure" whereas many have "Strongly Agreed" to the same.
6. Many students are not aware of the ICT Skills addition and the Technological contribution of the curriculum. However Most of the Students have "Agreed" and "Strongly Agreed" for the same parameter.
7. Majority of students have marked "Agreed" and "Strongly Agreed" for the importance and objectivity of the Regular Assessments and Evaluations. Many students have not understood the importance of Assessment and Evaluation of the Curriculum.
8. The students have rated all the parameters above the scale of 3.5.
9. This was a satisfactory result for the institute, whereby the students seemed satisfied with the Course Syllabi.
